To view ACMEC Grand Rounds on Wednesday mornings via WebEx:

- Go to www.webex.com
- Select Join (top right corner of screen)
- Enter **627635685** for Meeting Number / Meeting Information
- Follow prompts which may include authentication (i.e. I am not a robot) and request to download browser plugin or view through browser, both of which are okay to use.
- When prompted, continue to select **Join Meeting** and enter the Password **ACMEC2019** to log in. You may be asked to enter this multiple times so please use the same password when prompted.
- Connect to Audio through your computer and be sure your speakers are turned on.
- Once connected, ensure you monitor the Chat function (talk bubble in tool bar icons in bottom center of screen) for announcements and to submit your questions to the speaker.
- If you are using a mobile device you may want to download the WebEx App to streamline login.
