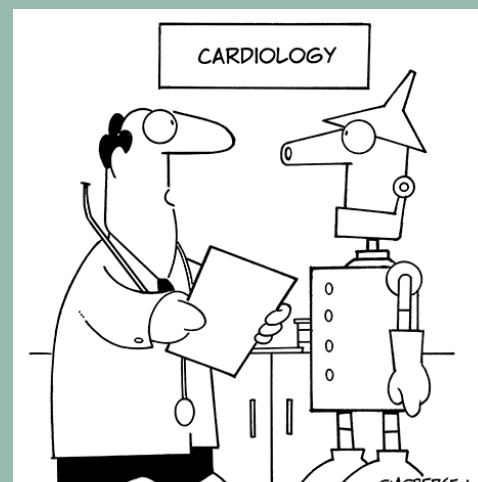

Updated applications, instructions and materials are now available directly through ACMEC. Therefore, we ask all planners and coordinators who intend to certify an activity or series for CME credit in 2019 to contact ACMEC early in the planning process to discuss their plans.

As a reminder:

- Outdated materials **WILL NOT** be accepted.
- Applications will not be considered complete and ready for review until all information requested is submitted. **ACMEC will not accept incomplete applications for review.**
- Complete applications must be submitted at least **60 days prior** to activity/series start date.
- Renewing activities (approved in 2018) may request a waiver of this requirement, but must do so at least two weeks prior to their 60 day deadline.
- Renewing series (approved in 2018) must be submitted at least **30 days prior** to series start date.
- Check with ACMEC before starting an application for the most up to date instructions and forms.

UPDATE: ACMEC GRAND ROUNDS WEBEX VIEWING NEW ONLINE VIEWING PLATFORM AND MEETING NUMBER

WebEx, the platform ACMEC uses to broadcast weekly Grand Rounds online in real time, has been updated. This update required us to set up Grand Rounds as a new meeting, with a new meeting number, on their new platform. While your login process should stay the same, online participants will need to discontinue the use of the old meeting number.

TO VIEW GRAND ROUNDS REMOTELY VIA WEBEX STARTING SEPT. 5TH:

1. Go to www.webex.com.
2. Select **Join** (top right corner of screen).
3. Enter **Meeting Number 627 635 685** (no spaces), along with your name and email address.
4. Connect to **Audio** through your computer and be sure your speakers are turned on.
5. If you are using a mobile device, you may want to download the WebEx App.

Please note that if you are using the WebEx App or a WebEx desktop application (other than a web browser), you will be required to use **Password ACMEC2018** to log in.
