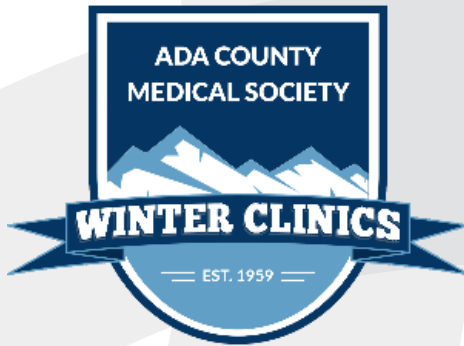

### As a reminder:

- Outdated materials **WILL NOT** be accepted.
- Applications will not be considered complete and ready for review until all information requested is submitted. **ACMEC will not accept incomplete applications for review.**
- Complete applications must be submitted at least **60 days prior** to activity/series start date.
- Renewing activities (approved in 2019) may request a waiver of this requirement, but must do so at least two weeks prior to their 60 day deadline.
- Renewing series (approved in 2019) must be submitted at least **30 days prior** to series start date.
- Check with ACMEC before starting an application for the most up to date instructions and forms.
