GRAND ROUNDS' OUT FOR SUMMER! GRAND ROUNDS' BACK IN SEPTEMBER!

ACMEC is excited to wrap up Grand Rounds for the semester with a slate of great talks during the month of June.

Most of the month will consist of the last batch of the annual FMRI resident talks. First up is Dr. Nicole Ruske with **Female Sexual Dysfunction** on June 1st, followed by Dr. Adam Schwind with **Common Injuries in the Cyclist** on June 3rd, Dr. Carolyn Johnson with a **Women's Health Update** on June 8th, and Dr. Amy Mandeville with **Perinatal Palliative Care** on June 17th. The last FMRI talk, **Chronic Disease Implications for Mother and Offspring Following Preeclampsia**, will be presented by this year's OB/GYN fellow, Dr. Stephanie McCullough, on June 22nd.

On June 10th, Dr. Jay Agarwal, Chief of the Division of Plastic Surgery at the University of Utah Huntsman Cancer Institute, will present **Breast Reconstruction After Breast Cancer/Mastectomy**. In this talk, Dr. Agarwal will discuss the latest advances in breast reconstruction after a mastectomy. Dr. Agarwal's talk is the fourth session presented in partnership with the Saint Alphonsus Cancer Cen-

ter and the University of Utah Huntsman Cancer Institute.

On June 15th, Dr. Mark McConnell, Chair of the Department of Pediatrics at St. Luke's Children's Hospital, and Dr. Cara Gallegos, Assistant Professor at the Boise State University School of Nursing, will present **Patient Safety/Highly Reliable Organizations**. In this talk, they will discuss adapting and applying the principles of high-reliability science to health care for improved patient safety at St. Luke's Children's Hospital.

To close out the month, Dr. Marvin Alviso, will be presenting a talk on **Transgender Medicine** on June 24th. Then, on June 29th, Dr. Abhilash Desai will present an update on the recently released **2016 American Psychiatric Association Practice Guidelines for Use of Antipsychotics in Persons With Dementia**.

FAQs for the New ACMEC CloudCME Portal

The new ACMEC CloudCME portal is up and running! We appreciate those members who have gone in to the system to update their profiles and view the new functions the portal offers. We also appreciate you letting us know when there is an issue so we can troubleshoot and make the system better for all.

As members have started using the system, there have been a few frequently asked questions and process walkthroughs that we thought would be helpful to address:

ACCOUNTS

Current ACMEC members were mailed letters with their temporary login information. However, in the interim, some of you have created new accounts. Please be advised that the self-creation of accounts affects our ability to properly align your credit history as the system does not connect the two accounts. To avoid this issue, if you are not a current ACMEC member or have misplaced your login information, please give us a call so we can help you accordingly. Please do not create your own account.

PASSWORD RESET


You may reset your temporary password and update it to something you prefer. To do so, once you have successfully updated your email address, log out, click on **Login to the Portal**, and select **Forgot Your Password?** The system will send you an email with a password reset link. Please be advised that

some organizations have tight firewalls that may prevent the message from coming through or will divert it to your junk. The message will come from **CloudCME <acmec@acmec.org>**, so please make sure to add this to your safe-senders list.

UPLOADING TO YOUR TRANSCRIPT

The new CloudCME portal allows members to upload copies of their certificates for CME activities not certified by ACMEC, and have them included in your transcript. To do this, you need to have an electronic copy of the certificate (pdf, Word or Excel file) saved to your computer.

To auto-append the file to the end of your transcript, follow these steps:

1. Log in to the ACMEC CloudCME portal at <https://acmec.cloud-cme.com>.
2. From the menu on the left side of the screen, click on Transcript.
3. Once you are taken to the Transcript page, locate the light blue shaded box.
4. In this box, locate the Upload button and click.
5. Once the Upload screen pops up, locate the green  Upload plus sign that reads Upload and click.
6. In the new window, click Select to search on your computer for the file you want to upload (same process as adding an attachment to an email), and click Open.

7. Once you see that the file has been loaded, click on the Upload button at the bottom of the window to upload.
8. You will then be taken to the Upload screen again, where you will see the file listed under Filename.
9. If you right click on the file, you will be able to Open, Delete, or Rename the file. Otherwise, if you are done, close out of the Upload screen and return to the portal Transcript page.
10. Scroll to the end of your transcript and you will see the file appended.

MOBILE APP

If you have an Apple iOS device (iPhone, iPod Touch, iPad), or an Android device, you can download the CloudCME app to your device. The app provides rapid access to most of the features available in the portal, including your transcript and the calendar.

To use the app, download it to your device and login using our organization code of ACMEC. Once you enter the code, you will enter the same username (email) and password that you use to access the portal. The app will remember your login, so the organization code and login are one-time steps. Once you are logged in, tap any button in the app to view that section.

We hope this information helps you better navigate the new ACMEC CloudCME portal!
