The information collected through the evaluation will help provide insight into any improvements needed for Grand Rounds, as well as help shape the slate of topics for the upcoming year.

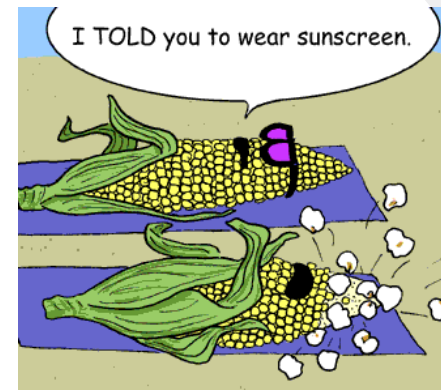
